While in FBR status the individual:

- Will receive all free (emailed) notifications that are sent to club members.
- Will not be mailed a NeoGram, although they will be notified of publication and may certainly buy any issue by sending a note and payment to the club Secretary.
- May participate in non-binding surveys or studies that the club's board of directors may choose to send to Members and FBR's.
- May participate in board-approved club-endorsed internet activities for members.
- May choose to join the club at any time using the regular membership process (they don't have to wait for the end of their FBR status to apply.)

Our expectation is that the FBR individual will be able to use this status as an opportunity get to know other club members and to learn about the USNMC, its initiatives and its needs from the inside.
